“One thing I know, that though I was blind, now I see”

He works a miracle which is no common one, but one which took place then for the first time: ...one born blind ...It was He who saw the blind man, not the blind man who came to Him ...How then is it said, “Who visits the sins of the parents upon the children unto the third and fourth generation” (Deut. 5:9)? ...The assertion is not universal, but it is spoken with reference to a certain one who came out of Egypt.

“What,” someone says, “did he suffer wrong for the glory of God?” What wrong, tell me? For what if God had never willed to produce him at all? But I assert that he even received benefit from his blindness, since he recovered the sight of his eyes within. What were the Jews profited by their eyes? ...Sin alone is an evil, but blindness is not an evil ...He calls faith a “work” ...He replies, “This the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent. –St. John Chrysostom, Homily 56 on John 9: 1-2.
